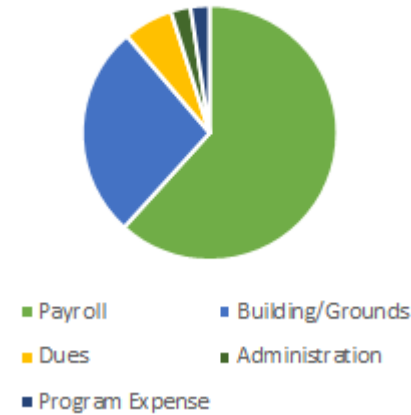
- The two families who received kitchen gear after their households were destroyed by the Memorial Day tornadoes;

### 2019-2020 Accomplishments

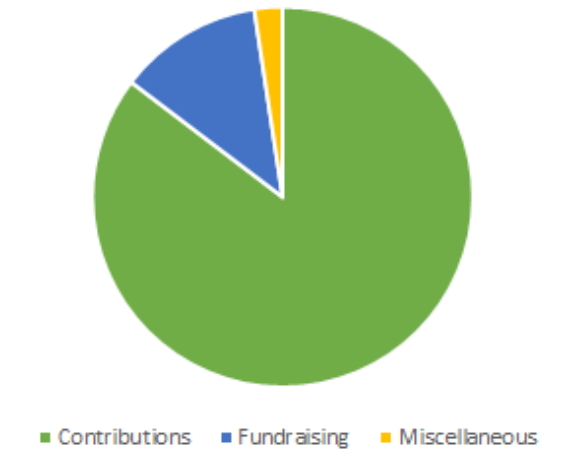
- Marching in the 2019 Gay Pride Parade in June
