

CYRE NEWS







Not true, though. And in the beginning, it was difficult and confusing and



Yule Overnight has presentations all night, with topics ranging from Pendulums, to Appalachian Divination, to arts & crafts. Each presentation is unique, and provides individual and interesting views of paganism, and some good fun!



Doors open at 6:00 PM on Saturday, DEC 16th. Our three main rituals will occur at 7:00 PM, 12:00 AM, and 6:00 AM. Rituals and presentations become more silly as the evening progresses. This tradition of letting loose and getting a bit more silly ties into the festivities of staying up to watch the log, the joy & merriment that comes with being able to rejoice over the long night.
